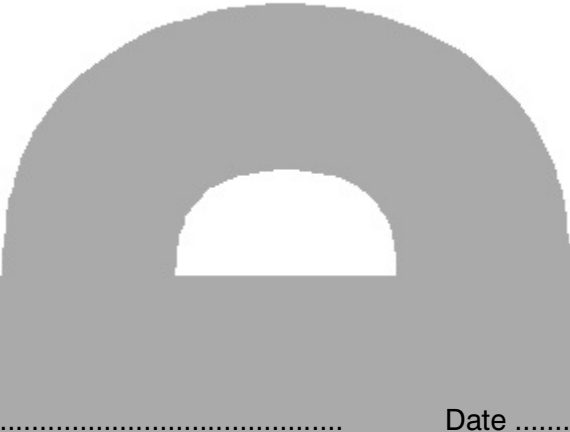
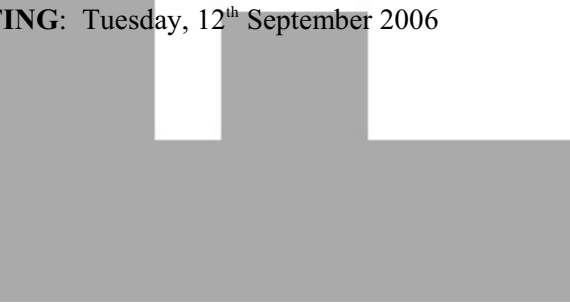


- 06/07/72 **PRESENT:** Cllrs Fraser (in the Chair), Chilcott, Mackay and Hamblyn.
- 06/07/73 **ALSO PRESENT:** 6 members of the public and DCllr Kingham.
- 06/07/74 **APOLOGIES:** Cllr Westmaas (away) and CCllr Huxtable
- 06/07/75 **IN ATTENDANCE:** Clerk to the Council
- 06/07/76 **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST ON AGENDA ITEMS:** none declared.
- 06/07/77 **HIGHWAYS:** Any urgent problems arising and updates - pot hole outside Briar House, The Nidon is in very poor condition past the bridge and on to Burtle, some areas of Manor Road also bad. Map of adopted roads in Catcott to be looked for. Broken fire hydrant outside Cheese Cottage.
- 06/07/78 **DISTRICT COUNCILLOR'S REPORT:** Stuart reported on the new integrated contract for collection of household waste due to come into force in 2007.
- 06/07/79 **PLANNING:**
- a. 14/06/00002/STH - Erection of two detached dwellings, one detached flat with ground floor garages, detached garages and formation of access at land to the North and West of 9 Lippetts Way - outline - permission has been granted. A unilateral agreement has recently been made in respect of policies RLT2 and RLT3 and the certificate should be released shortly.
 - b. 14/06/00008 - Erection of stables to the North of Greenacres, Brook Lane - amended plans received. Previous comments still stand.
 - c. 14/06/00009 - Erection of dwelling, formation of parking and access on land to the West of 3 Weares Lane - Clerk had responded between meetings, following consultation, due to lack of time. She read the comments to the meeting.
 - d. Village Design Statement - This had again been sent to Rob Shuttleworth (SDC). Cllr Mackay said the latest comments were that the section on mains drainage was too contentious. It was felt that the document would soon represent SDC's views rather than Catcott's.
 - e. SDC letter re provision of outdoor playing space for children in association with new residential development - Agreed Clerk should ask if the funds are available for children under 12 years. If so, it was agreed that funds be asked for provision of new swings. Clerk to find out what LEAP and NEAP are acronyms for.
 - f. Any other planning matters/updates - An email from Steve Atkinson reporting back on matters raised at the previous meeting was read aloud.
- 06/07/80 **FINANCE:**
- a. Change of bank account - forms for completion. Cllr Fraser would complete her sheet and return the bundle to the Clerk.
 - b. Cheques for signature - were agreed as follows - Chq.599 J A Marshall (Clerk's salary and expenses) £283.22; Chq.600 Richard Young (internal audit) £5.00. The following two payments were approved but await a new cheque book - A Dunster (Village Maintenance) £80.00 and CPRE (Subscription) £26.00.
 - c. Internal audit report - There had been no problems.
 - d. Any other financial matters for information - VAT repayment had been received.

- 06/07/82 **HERITAGE NOTICEBOARD:** Councillors were still considering the various options. Clerk to ask Polden Joinery for a price for a double door noticeboard.
- 06/07/83 **VILLAGE MAINTENANCE:** Agreed the Clerk should approach anyone who is interested in undertaking Edington's work.
- 06/07/84 **CEMETERY PROVISION:** Representative to attend meeting on Monday, 17th July re provision of burial spaces. Either Cllr Fraser or Cllr Mackay would attend. Letter regarding safety of memorials (from SDC) was passed to Cllr Fraser.
- 06/07/85 **CPRE** - CPRE Voice put for circulation.

- 06/07/86 **RIGHTS OF WAY AND FOOTPATHS:** Serious problems are arising from dog fouling on the school footpath. This is particularly unpleasant when balls have to be retrieved from the affected area. Clerk would contact Dog Warden. Dogways were explained to the meeting.
